Dear Sandy Lake Academy Dormitory Students:

Summer is coming to a close and it will soon be time to think about returning to school. We hope you had a fantastic summer and are ready for a great school year!

If you were living in the dorm last year, you know exactly what to bring or not to bring. Please remember when you are packing, the dorm rooms are only so big and the closets are small, so be conservative in the amount of things you bring. If you need to share a room, your roommate will need space too.

If you have never experienced living in a dorm, you need to know what you should bring besides your clothing, bedding, towels, curtains (window size is 42" long by 48" wide), personal care items and, of course, your school needs. A detailed list of items to bring is attached.

We are asking that each one of the dorm students please bring a lunch bag, water bottle, and some containers to carry your lunch in if want to take items to heat up at school.

Please check with the deans before hanging pictures in your room. You will need to use poster putty, as placing nails or hooks in the walls is prohibited. Your choice of décor should be in keeping with Christian standards.

Registration for the dorm students will be Sunday, September 4, 2017, from 2:00pm – 4:00 pm. The dormitory will open at 2:00 pm. for students to move in. The first meal served will be supper on September 4 at 5:30 pm.

A room deposit of \$60.00 (Cash Only) will be collected at the beginning of the year. The room deposit will be refunded when the room is inspected at the end of the school year and is found to be in satisfactory condition and when the room key is returned at the end of the school year.

Room deposit funds will be used by the deans to cover the cost of trips and parking when taking the student to the airport, the hospital, appointments, etc. Should these funds be depleted during the school year, and the room is found to be in unsatisfactory condition at the end of the year, the expense of repairing the room will be charged to the student.

Permission forms must be signed and submitted to the dean along with the \$60.00 deposit BEFORE each student will be allowed to move into a room.

If you are a returning student to Sandy Lake Academy Dorm, we want to welcome you back this school year and if you are a new student, we look forward to meeting you and welcoming you into our home!

LIST OF ITEMS YOU MAY WISH TO BRING TO THE DORMITORY

Each dorm room is fitted with a bed, closet, dresser, desk, and chair for your use. We encourage you to bring items that will make your room your own and make you feel at home here. A non-conclusive list has been assembled from other student's experiences and ideas.

Appropriate Items

- Lunch bag
- Water bottle
- Containers to carry your lunch in if want to take items to heat up at school.
- Poster Putty (It is not permitted to put holes in the walls with nails, etc.)
- Bible (also devotional books)
- Bedding (twin bed size, pillow)
- Towels/washcloths/soap and shampoo
- Shower shoes
- Personal hygiene items (deodorant, toothbrush, tooth paste, combs & brush)
- Power bar extension cord
- Desk lamp
- Laundry detergent/laundry basket/iron/hangers (An ironing board for student use is located on each hall.)
- School attire/working attire/church attire
- Swimsuit/sports equipment
- Sleeping bag
- Headphone
- Computer
- Fan
- Refrigerator

Inappropriate Items

- Weapons - firearms (Includes paint-ball & airsoft), machetes, knives, nun chucks, etc.
- Fireworks/firecrackers
- Pets
- TV/VCR/DVD/Blu-ray player
- External speakers - including iHomes, speakers that plug into the audio outlet or a USB
- Movies rated above PG
- Computer games that are inappropriate (Dean's discretion)
- Music/Lyrics that do not conform to Christian standards
- Video game systems and games
- Matches and lighters/ Incense/candles/open flame items
- Ovens, hot plates, toasters
- Posters that are inappropriate (Dean's discretion)

Bringing or having any of these items will result in having the item confiscated and sent home with you on the next break. These confiscated items are not to come back to the dorm once they have been confiscated during the school year.

Student Vehicle Permission Form

Use of a motor vehicle is a privilege.
